M/s ONGC Petro additions Limited was issued Letter of Approval No. KASEZ/P&C/6/28/07-08 dated 17th October, 2007. The unit has commenced commercial production w.e.f. 31.08.2015.

M/s. ONGC Petro additions Limited have set up a Greenfield 1.1 MMTPA Petrochemicals Complex (hereinafter referred to as 'Project') in the Special Economic Zone, Dahej, Gujarat. The principal business of OPaL is to manufacture, purchase process, market, distribute, import, export and trade petrochemicals. Petrochemicals products and its by-products.

M/s. ONGC Petro additions Limited have vide their letter dated 13.09.2018 had requested for seeking in-principal approval for exit of the unit (OPaL) from Dahej SEZ. The unit has been granted in-principle approval for exit from Dahej SEZ under Rule 74 of SEZ Rules, 2006 in 98th Unit Approval Committee Meeting held on 05.11.2020.

Further Rule 74(1) also provides that a penalty is also required to be imposed in case positive NFE has not been achieved by the Unit. This office had sent the APR's submitted by the firm to the Specified Officer, Dahej SEZ for verification, and is awaited. The unit had not achieved positive NFE for the cumulative block of four years.

Due to reasons briefly mentioned below, the OPaL intends to exit from Dahej SEZ and continue operations as a unit in Domestic Tariff Area (DTA).

- 1. Increased demand in the domestic market leading to net import situation.
- 2. Import substitution will save country' foreign exchange outlays.
- 3. Availability of polymers from domestic sources will help domestic industry.
- 4. Negative NFE on account of fulfilling domestic demand.
- 5. Improvement in operating margins of OPaL.
