

Minutes of 67th meeting of the Approval Committee for the multi-product Dahej-Special Economic Zone held on 19.04.2016, at 11.30 hours under the Chairpersonship of Smt. Lata Shukla, ITS, Development Commissioner, Dahej Special Economic Zone, in the Conference Room, of M/s. ONGC Petro Additions Ltd. (OPAL), Ground Floor, Omkara Building, Near Sai Chowkadi, Manjalpur, Vadodara-390 011.

Review/Confirmation of the Minutes of last meeting of the Approval Committee.

As no comments/observation on the last minutes of the 66th meeting of the Approval Committee of the Dahej SEZ held on 01-03-2016 were received from any member, the same were confirmed.

67.1 Fresh cases for unit in Dahej –SEZ:-

67.1.1 M/s Power Band Industries Pvt. Ltd.

Shri Rajan Desai of the applicant company appeared before the committee, and gave a detailed presentation of their project in Dahej-SEZ, which is as under:-

- (i) The proposal is to manufacture and export Plastic Film, Bopp Hotmelt Tape, Paper Masking Tape.
- (ii) Total cost of project is Rs.20, 500 lakhs which will be borne by internal accruals and external commercial borrowings. The project will generate employment for 260 persons.
- (iii) Total exports are projected at Rs.203000.00 lakhs with outgo of Rs.89500.00 lakhs, resulting in NFE earnings of Rs.113500.00 lakhs in five year period.

The Committee after due deliberation approved the proposed project, subject to compliance of the SEZ Act, 2005 and SEZ Rules, 2006.

Item No. 67.3.01 M/s. Sigachi Cellulos Pvt. Ltd., Dahej – SEZ - Request for broad banding of LoA to include additional items for trading and enhancement in production capacity of Microcrystalline Cellulose.

Shri Amit Raj Sinha, MD of the applicant company appeared before the Committee and explained their request for enhancement in production capacity of existing product and trading activities. They intend to enhance production capacity of Microcrystalline Cellulose [ITC(HS) code 39129090] from 1200 MT to 6000 MT per annum. The unit has also requested to broad-banding of LoA to add new products for trading activity i.e. a) Sodium Carboxy Methyl Cellulose (ITC (HS)- Code- 39123100); b) Calcium Carboxy Methyl Cellulose (ITC (HS)- Code- 39123100); c) Sodium Starch Glycolate (ITC (HS)- Code-29420090) ; d) Lactose Monohydrate (ITC (HS)- Code- 17021190); e) Purified Talc (ITC (HS)- Code-25262000); f) Pregelatinized Starch (ITC (HS)- Code-35051090); g) Maize starch (ITC (HS)- Code-11081200); h) Calcium carbonate (ITC (HS)- Code-28365000); i) Polyethylene Glycol (ITC (HS)- Code-334049020).

The committee after due deliberation approved enhancement in capacity of existing item and the above cited items for trading in the LoA. The approval is subject to compliance of the



SEZ Act, 2005 and SEZ Rules, 2006. Further, the unit shall achieve positive NFE separately for manufacturing and trading activity and shall submit separate APRs for both the activities. No DTA sales shall be allowed for the above approved trading items.

**M/s P & J Cretechem (P) Ltd –
Request for broad-banding of Letter of Approval –
inclusion of additional products/new products to the
LOA.**

Shri Mohan Pandey, Commercial manager of the applicant company appeared before the Committee and explained their request for broad-banding of LOA. They intend to include new product for manufacture and export of Viz. 1) Aluminum Sulphate (ITC (HS)- Code- 28333090) - 400 MT per month.

The committee after due deliberation approved the request for broad banding of LOA, subject to the compliance of the SEZ Act, 2005 and SEZ Rules, 2006 and approval will be reviewed after 6 months to assess the export performance of the unit.
